Greater Mystic Chamber of Commerce Annual Community Service Award

Criteria Information

This honor is awarded to a special individual or organization for outstanding service to the community of Greater Mystic. This award is presented annually.

No candidate will be considered who is paid to perform the services for which they were nominated, unless their contribution encompassed altruism toward the community far beyond the dictates of their job.

Nominations are in no way restricted based on age, sex, race, occupation, religion or membership in the chamber.

There is no time limit during which the nominee's distinguished service to the community was rendered... the previous year, recent years or a lifetime of service all qualify.

The number of times the same individual is nominated each year will have no bearing in the selection process. Only the accomplishments and services of the nominee will be considered.

Nominations must be made in writing on or before the date specified in letter form or on the nomination blank. Whichever form is used, however, it must bear the signature of the person making the nomination.

While the board will attempt to select a single award recipient, special conditions may be present in which dual awards may be given. This is the prerogative of the board.
