Criteria Information

This annual award is presented to an employer for outstanding service to his or her employees.

1. The nominee must be the head of the organization such as the owner, general manager or president of the company or division of the company.
2. Nominations are in no way restricted based on age, sex, race, occupation, religion or membership in the chamber.
3. There is no time limit during which the nominee's distinguished service to the employees was rendered... the previous year, recent years or a lifetime of service all qualify.
4. Only the accomplishments of the nominee will be considered; the number of times the same individual is nominated each year will have no bearing in the selection process.
5. Nominations must be made in writing on or before the date specified in letter form or on the nomination blank. Whichever form is used, however, it must bear the signature of the person making the nomination.
6. While the board will attempt to select a single award recipient, special conditions may be present in which dual awards may be given. This is the prerogative of the board.
